Summary

Describes the major purpose of this position and its role in the department and/or organization.

Repairs, fabricates, adjusts and maintains all District Cemetery machinery and equipment. Recommends when to sub contract repairs and when to replace equipment and parts. Coordinates with cemetery staff to determine equipment and machinery needs. Orders parts and maintains inventory. Tracks and reports status and materials used in repairs.

Essential Functions

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the duties and responsibilities required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Repairs and orders parts for all machinery and equipment at all District cemeteries (i.e., trimmers, weedeaters, blowers, lawn mowers. trailers, funeral canopies, graters, backhoe, etc.).
 Includes changing or repairing flat or broken tires on all equipment and machinery at cemeteries.
- 2. Adjusts, tunes-up and maintains all equipment and machinery at all cemetery locations (i.e., change air filters, pumps, hoses, oil, check all fluids, etc.).
- 3. Maintains and delivers fuel for all equipment and machinery at all cemetery locations.
- 4. Maintains inventory records of all equipment/machinery and parts for all cemetery locations.
- 5. Provides written reports on equipment status including detail of parts and materials used for maintenance and repair purposes.
- 6. Fabricates equipment and parts as needed.
- 7. Uses welding equipment to weld repairs and fabricate equipment at all District cemeteries.
- 8. Recommends when to sub-contract large and complicated repairs or replacement of equipment/machinery when necessary to Cemetery Managers.



9.	Works daily with Cemetery Managers and Leadworkers to determine maintenance and
	equipment needs.

- 10. Mixes and pours cement for new sidewalks and other structures or to repair cracks as needed. May build structures as needed (i.e., cement patios, etc.).
- 11. Adhere to District policy and procedures and California Health & Safety Codes.
- 12. May be required to perform other related duties as assigned by management.
