When ordering your marker, niche plate or vase block, be sure that the size conforms to the requirements above. If you are having a photo affixed to your marker, you will need to sign a photo waiver form. Lot owners must consent to the installation by completing the Marker Purchase Acknowledgment Form. Setting fees must be paid, prior to installation. If you are ordering a bronze marker, you must pay for a marker base that is placed under the marker to support it. Bronze markers attached to granite bases are acceptable, provided they are within the size requirements. If you are not sure if you have paid these fees, please call the cemetery and we can confirm this for you. **Please note:** 32"x20" markers are oversized and the setting fee is \$420.00. The setting fee for all other markers is \$300.00. The Niche Plate setting fee is \$150.00. The setting fee for each vase block is \$115.00. A maximum of two vase blocks are allowed on each gravesite where space allows. If a second marker is placed on a full casket space, the 2nd Marker Endowment Care Fee of \$200 must be paid. The cemetery is not responsible for marker fading, painted lettering fading, or spalling of markers due to rain or irrigation. Marker and niche plate designs must be landscape in orientation.

CEMENT BORDERS ARE PROHIBITED: In lieu of cement borders, families may order a two-inch faux/etched border, but markers must still comply with the above size requirements. No marker feature may be raised higher than 3/8" above the surface of the marker.

PLEASE NOTE: Accepted marker materials are granite, marble and bronze only. The depth of all stone markers and vase blocks must be a solid piece that is at least three inches thick. Bronze markers require payment for a marker base. All markers are flat, and installed flush with the ground. If a marker or niche plate is received that does not comply with these specifications it can be rejected.
